#### **Back-to-School Block Party**

Each year in August during National Health Center Week we hold a Back-to-School block party. This event is free and open to the public. During the block party children heading back to school can receive free well child checks, dental exams, immunizations, and sports physicals. The afternoon/evening also includes a free meal, activities for the kids, as well as information for the families. We partner with many local organizations including United Way of North Central lowa in Cerro Gordo County. Local businesses and organizations can get involved by having a table at the event or by donating goods, services or money to off-set the expense of the meal and activities.

#### Make it OK - Mental Health Walk

Make it Ok day is an initiative of Iowa's Healthiest State. Each year in May we partner with local organizations to plan a lunch-time walk to bring awareness to mental health and help eliminate the stigma. The walk is held in partnership with the Mason City Workforce Committee at Central Park in Mason. This event includes resources from CHC and other area local organizations on mental health.

#### **Giving Tuesday**

We hold an online fundraiser each year on Giving Tuesday which is the Tuesday after Thanksgiving. Funds raised through this initiative go to assisting patients with co-pays, bus tokens, and other needs that prevent them from getting needed health care.

This year on top of our usual services and clinic needs, we will be putting the funds raised towards the purchase of an Cepheid PCR machine. This innovative technology allows us to perform rapid tests for Flu, COVID-19, and RSV with just one swab, making the process faster and less invasive—especially for children. Results are available in just 36 minutes, and the test is covered by Medicare, Medicaid, and is available to those on our sliding fee scale, ensuring it is accessible to all. This initiative will also provide valuable support to nursing home staff and others who require frequent testing.
